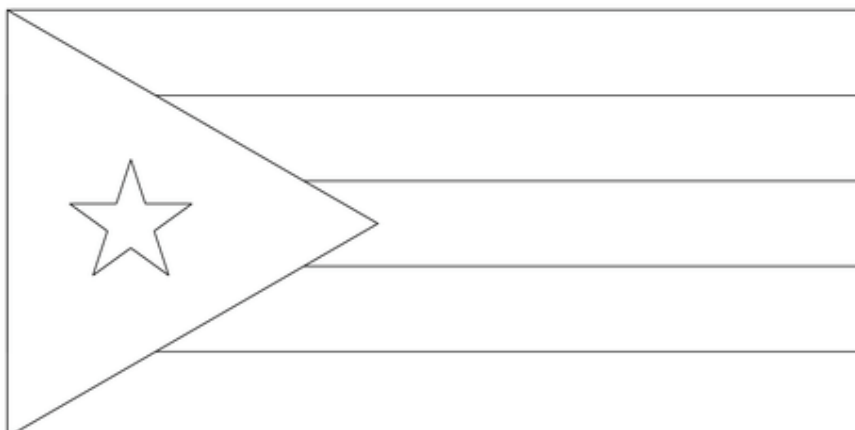
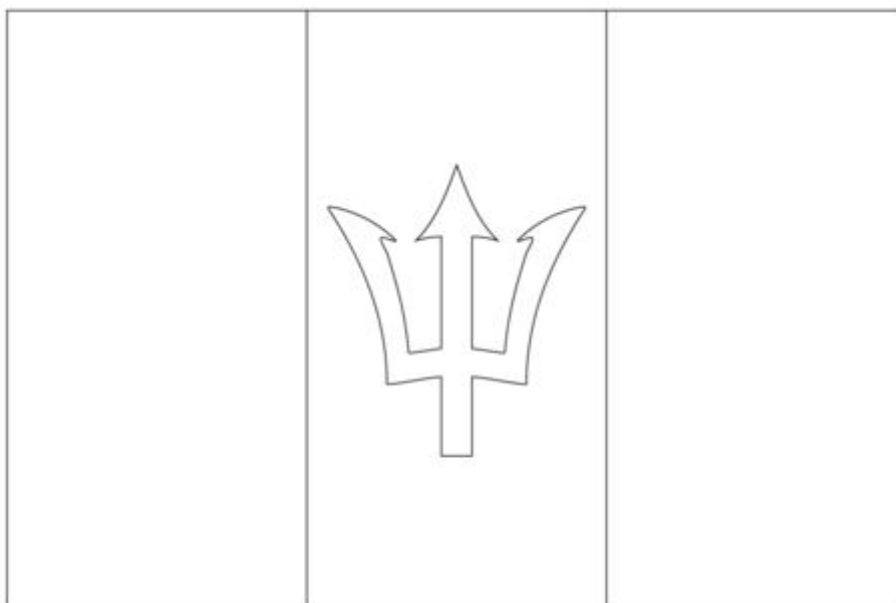


Flagi niektórych państw leżących na Karaibach. Pokoloruj !



Flag of Cuba

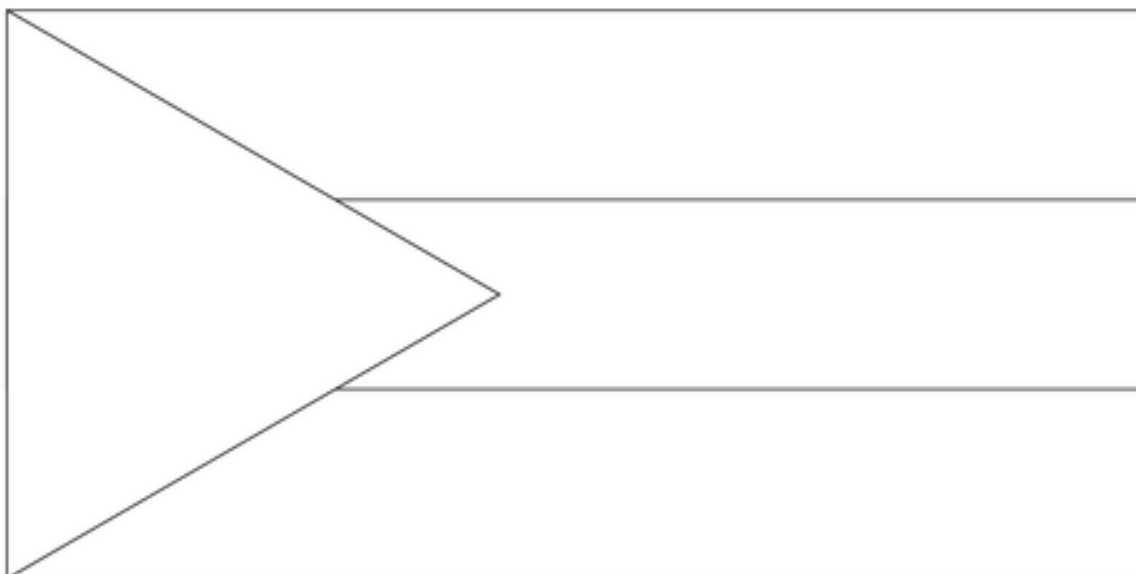
Adopted on June 25, 1848. Designed by Narciso López and Miguel Teurbe Tolón.
The blue stripes refer to the three old divisions of the island; and the two white stripes represent the strength of the independent ideal. The red triangle symbolizes equality, fraternity and freedom, as well as the blood shed in the island's struggle for independence. The white star symbolizes the absolute freedom among the Cuban people.



Flag of Barbados

Adopted November 30, 1966. Designed by Grantley W. Prescott.
The flag consists of a triband of two bands of ultramarine, which are said to stand for the ocean; separated by a golden middle band, representing the sand on the island. A black trident-head is centred within the golden band. The trident symbol was taken from Barbados' colonial badge, where the trident is shown with Britannia holding it.

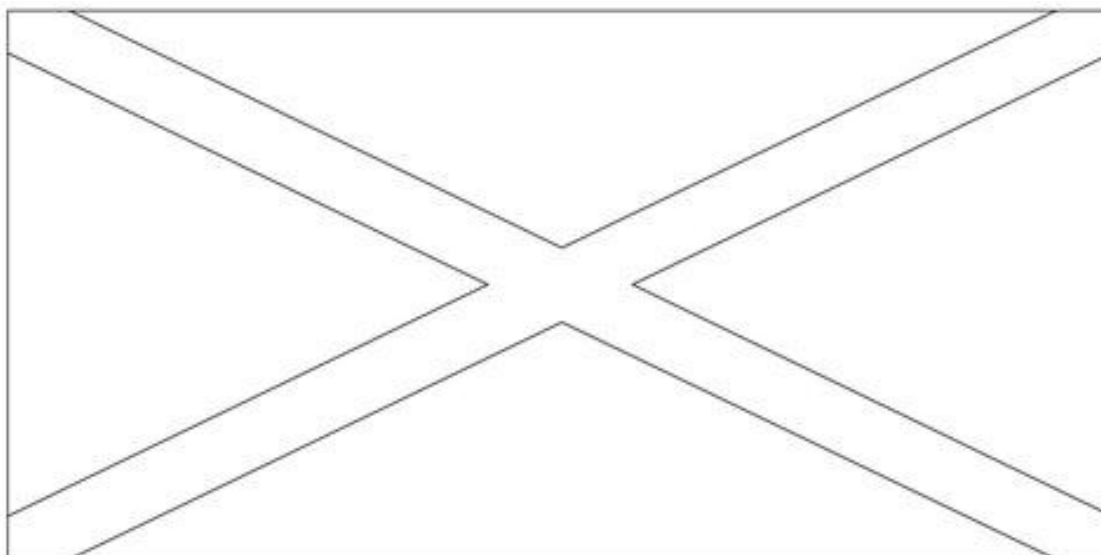

Flag of the Bahamas

Adopted on July 10, 1973. Designed by Dr. Hervis Bain.

The yellow alludes to the golden sand on the islands' beaches while the aquamarine epitomizes the sea surrounding the country. The black symbolizes the "strength" of the Bahamian people, the directed triangle evokes their "enterprising and determined" nature to cultivate the abundant natural resources on the land and in the sea.

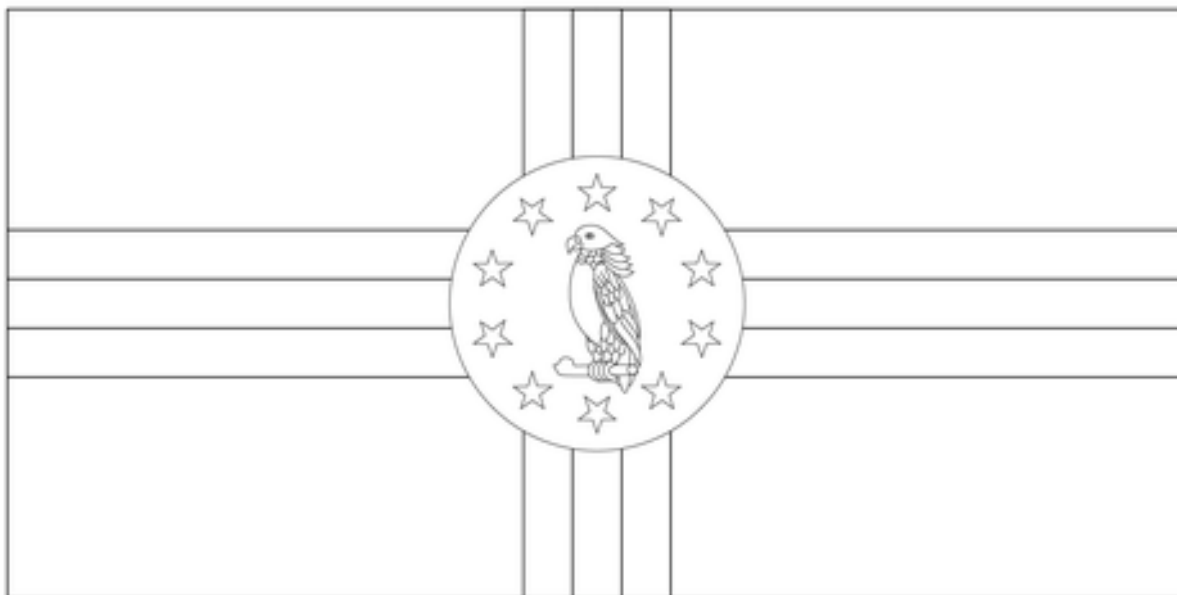


Flag of Jamaica - The Cross, Black, Green, and Yellow

Adopted on August 6, 1962

The flag design hints at the Scottish and Irish roots of much of the population, while black, green, and gold are Pan-African colors, representing the country's black majority population. Officially the black color represents the strength and creativity of the people which has allowed them to overcome the odds, yellow stands for the golden sunshine, and green for the lush vegetation of the island.

Flag of Dominica

Adopted on November 3, 1978.

The flag features the national bird emblem, the sisserou parrot, it is an endangered species. The green field represents the lush vegetation of the island. The cross represents the Trinity and Christianity, with its three colours symbolising the native Indians, the fertile soil, and the pure water.
